

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, Harry W. Flagg, of Brockton, Plymouth County, Massachusetts, Public Administrator of the estate of Margaret E. Cohen, late of said Brockton, deceased, intestate, by power conferred by decree of the Probate Court of Plymouth County in said Commonwealth, dated June 26, 1933, and every other power, for Forty-six Hundred (\$4600) Dollars paid, grant to Fred W. Glasier and Emma Glasier, both of said Brockton, to hold as joint tenants and not as tenants in common, and not as tenants by the entirety, two certain parcels of land, described in said decree as Parcel B and Parcel C to wit: Parcel B. Being lot No. 9 on a "Plan of Houselots, Bridgewater, Mass., owned by Jesse A. Case, A. P. Trufant, C.E., May 1, 1914", on file in Plymouth County Registry of Deeds. Parcel C: A certain parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated on the easterly side of Beebe Road in BRIDGEWATER, Plymouth County, Massachusetts, bounded beginning at the Northerly corner of said lot in the easterly line of said Beebe Road, and thence running southeasterly by lot No. 10 on a plan hereinafter described, ninety-eight and 53/100 (98.53) feet to a corner; thence southwesterly seventy and 05/100 (70.05) feet to a corner; thence northwesterly by Lot No. 14 on said plan, one hundred one and 23/100 (101.23) feet to the easterly line of said Beebe Road; and thence northeasterly by the easterly line of said Beebe Road, seventy (70) feet to the point of beginning. Being lot No. 12 on a "Plan of Houselots, Bridgewater, Mass., owned by Jesse A. Case, A. P. Trufant, C.E., May 1, 1914, on file in Plymouth County Registry of Deeds. Said Parcels B and C being sold subject to a mortgage covering both said parcels, on which there is a balance due of One Thousand (\$1000) Dollars, dated July 16, 1924, given by Margaret E. Cohen to Brockton Savings Bank and recorded in Plymouth County Registry of Deeds in Book 1462, Page 585, and to any unpaid interest thereon.
