

Know all Men by these Presents

that *William Lloyd Garrison* of *Dorchester* in the County of *Suffolk* and Commonwealth of *Massachusetts*

in consideration of *Twenty Seven Hundred & 25 Cents* Dollars to me paid by *William C. Adams* of *Dorchester* a corporation established under the laws of said Commonwealth and located at *Dorchester* in the County of *Suffolk* and Commonwealth of *Massachusetts* by which whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said *William C. Adams* and his assigns forever the said *Electric Illuminating Company of Dorchester* its successors and assigns a certain parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situated in said *Dorchester* on the *Westerly* side of *Abbott's* street containing in *round* three hundred *thirty* (330) feet more or less and bounded *northerly* by *Lincoln* street, *easterly* by *Abbott's* street, *southerly* by *South* street and *westerly* by *South* street or formerly of *George W. Adams*, the *Westerly* line of said lot herein described being parallel with said *Abbott's* street and fifty (50) feet *Westerly* from the *Westerly* line of said street being the same premises conveyed to me by *George W. Adams* aforesaid by deed dated *May 14 1853* and is recorded herewith

To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said *Electric Illuminating Company of Dorchester* and its assigns forever.

And I do hereby, for myself and my heirs, executors, and administrators, covenant with the said grantee and his assigns, that I lawfully seized in fee-simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me.

That I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that I, my heirs, executors and administrators shall WARRANT AND DEFEND the same to the said grantee and his assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through, or under me, my heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, or assigns.

And for the consideration aforesaid *William C. Adams* wife of the said *William Lloyd Garrison*

do hereby release unto the said grantee and his assigns, all right of or to both DOWER AND HOMESTEAD in the granted premises.
