

Know all men by these presents

I, Mary T. Ward, of Brookton, County of Plymouth, and
State of Massachusetts,

To consider and other valuable considerations,
given to Frank P. Gardner, of said Brookton, said Society,
said Commonwealth aforesaid.

Frank P. Gardner, a parcel of land with there buildings
thereon situated on the corner of Bellevue Avenue and
said Brookton, bounded and described as follows, viz:-
Beginning at the south line of Bellevue Avenue, at a point
thirty hundred and eighty (380) feet distant easterly from
the east line of Spofford Avenue; thence southerly by a
line parallel with the east line of said Spofford Avenue
and hundred and thirty-two (132) feet, thence easterly
by a line parallel with the south line of said Bellevue
Avenue, fifty (50) feet, thence westerly by a line par-
allel with the said first above described line hundred
and thirty-two (132) feet to the south line of said
Bellevue Avenue; thence westerly by the south line of
said Bellevue Avenue fifty feet to the point of beginning.
Being the easterly boundary of lot No. 366 and the westerly
boundary of lot No. 37, or a plan of house lots at Bell-
vue Park drawn by E. L. Brown, Esq., Brookton, Mass. 1890
filed with Plymouth Registry of Deeds. Being a part of the
premises conveyed to me by deed of Brookton Savings
Bank, recorded with Plymouth Registry of Deeds Book
934, Page 114, subject to be mortgaged to Brookton Savings
Bank for one thousand and fifty dollars, subject to
taxes of 1913.
