✓ We, HAROLD ANTI and CLARA M. ANTI, husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, of Plymouth, Plymouth County, Massachusetts, being unmarried, for consideration paid, grant to GIUSEPPE GARIBALDI CLUB, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of Massachusetts and being located in said Plymouth, with QUITCLAIM COVENANTS, All those parcels of land situated on the Northerly side of Castle Street Extension, so-called, and on the Westerly side of Castle Court, so-called, in said PLYMOUTH; and being Lots No. 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13 as delineated on a plan entitled "Plan of House Lots in Plymouth, Mass. on Castle Street Extension, owned by Leopold J. Schreiber et als, dated December 14, 1923, Delano & Keith, Civil Engineers"; including the land in the rear of Lot No. 8 extended Northerly to land of Hodges. Said parcels as one parcel are bounded and described substantially as follows: Southerly by said Castle Street Extension, 150 feet; Easterly by Castle Court, so-called, 236.5 feet, more or less; Northerly by land of the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Boston, 150 feet; Westerly by land now or formerly of Schreiber and by Lot No. 7 as shown on said plan, and by a straight line, 239 feet, more or less. Together with a right of way in common with others over Castle Street Extension to Castle Street, from Castle Court to Castle Street Extension and thence to Castle Street and over Castle Court to Castle Street Extension and over Castle Street Extension Easterly to Atlantic Avenue and thence Southerly to Atlantic Street. For our title, see deed of John J. Schreiber, dated October 25, 1941 and recorded with Plymouth County Deeds, Book 1817, Page 313. We, Harold Anti and Clara M. Anti, husband and wife, release to said grantee all rights of tenancy by the curtesy and dower and homestead and other interests therein. WITNESS our hands and seals this 27th day of October 1948.
