It is now all given by these Provisions, that I Jesse Morwick of Carver and the
 County of Plymouth and Commonwealth of Massachusetts - Esquire - in consideration
 of One Hundred dollars to me paid by Matthias Ellis of Carver aforesaid
 Manufacturer of the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give grant
 bargain sell and convey unto the said Matthias Ellis - such undivided part of
 the following described lot of land as will make him a tenant in common in
 equal share with me. Said lot of land is bounded as follows - Beginning at
 the South West corner of the highway of the Rolling Dam of S. Ellis by the road
 runs in said Carver thence running South eighty three degrees East two rods
 and twenty links to the South East corner of the boundary thence South eighty
 six and a half degrees East two rods and twenty two links to a stone gate post
 thence North sixty five degrees East five rods and six links to a post standing two
 feet South of the black hole; thence North forty eight degrees East fifteen rods to
 the State Factory Brook; thence North West by the said brook (crossing East
 of said State Factory and close to the East end of said Factory) sixteen rods to
 the end of the head of the Channel; thence by the line S. 63° N. sixteen
 rods - S. 21° E. four rods - S. 5° N. eight rods - S. 42° N. eight and one
 half rods to the West side of the Rolling Dam flume; thence South 26° E. three
 and a quarter rods to the corner of the above way first mentioned
 Reserving to myself my heirs and assigns the right of way for waggon car-
 rages and on foot in travelling across said lot, going to and from the farm of
 which my father died seized of to the public highway -
 to Head and to Flock the above granted Provisions with all the privileges
 and appurtenances to the same belonging, to the said Matthias Ellis his

heirs and assigns to his heirs their heirs and assigns forever -
 And I the said Grantor for myself and my heirs Executors and Administra-
 tors do covenant with the said Grantee and his heirs and assigns that
 I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted Provisions; that they are
 free from all incumbrances - except a public highway across the said land -
 that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Grantee and his
 heirs and assigns forever as aforesaid - and that I will and my heirs Execu-
 tors and Administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Grantee
 and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all
 persons except the right of the public or said highway.

 and sixty.
