I, CHARLOTTE E. CROWLEY of Whitman, Plymouth County, Massachusetts, being married, for consideration paid, grant to KENNETH D. WAKEFIELD and RUTH WAKEFIELD husband and wife as tenants by the entirety, and not as joint tenants, both of North Easton, Bristol County, with WARRANTY COVENANTS the land in said Whitman, together with the buildings thereon, said parcel containing about two (2) acres and is located at the corner of Auburn and Bedford Streets, and is bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of the lot at the corner of Auburn and Bedford Streets; thence northerly by said Bedford Street to land now or formerly of Priscilla Holmes; thence westerly by land now or formerly of said Holmes to land formerly of E.B.French; thence southerly by land formerly of said French about fourteen (14) rods and twenty-four (24) links; thence easterly and southerly by the old wall by land formerly of said French to Auburn Street; thence easterly by said Auburn Street, seven (7) rods and twelve (12) links, more or less, to the point of beginning. Being the same premises conveyed to Charlotte E. Crowley by deed of Thomas Carr, dated July 29, 1927, and recorded with Plymouth County Registry of Deeds, Book 1553, Page 390. Subject to a Mortgage, originally in the amount of Sixty Five Hundred Dollars (\$6500.00) held by the Security Cooperative Bank of said Brockton. I, John J.
