



Emergency Homeowners' Loan Program (EHLP)

Neighborhood Housing Services of the South Shore

will host three informational sessions to assist struggling homeowners looking for access to HUD's Emergency Home Loan Program. This HUD Program, EHLP, was created to help homeowners who are temporarily and involuntarily unemployed or underemployed due to economic conditions or a medical condition, and are at risk of foreclosure. The EHLP will provide eligible homeowners with emergency assistance that pays a portion of their monthly mortgage payment for up to twenty-four consecutive months, up to \$50,000. Homeowners will be instructed to use the Pre-Applicant Screening Worksheet to determine if they might qualify for emergency assistance under the EHLP. Homeowners selected through the lottery will be contacted and scheduled for an appointment to complete a full EHLP application.

Pre-Applicant Screening Worksheet along with a signed Third Party Authorization form must be submitted to a participating counseling agency by July 22, 2011.
