

I Arthur J. Lennon Administrator of the Estate of John L. Sullivan by power by Admin. conferred by decision of the Probate Court for the County of Plymouth on April 28, 1919, and every other power for the Estate to pay five hundred (\$500) dollars; paid, grant to George H. Hatchard of Hull, Massachusetts, a certain lot of land containing sixty and $\frac{3}{4}$ (60 $\frac{3}{4}$ acres) more or less with

the buildings thereon, situated on the westerly side of Hancock Street in Abington in the County of Plymouth bounded and described as follows: Beginning on said Street at the Northeastly corner of the lot thence South 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West ninety-two (92) rods and ten (10) links to the river thence Southwesterly by the river nine (9) rods to a stake and stone thence South 68 $\frac{1}{3}$ degrees West fifty-four (54) rods and fifteen (15) links to a stake and stone thence South 68 $\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West seventy-four (74) rods and ten (10) links thence South 21 degrees East thirty (30) rods thence South 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East thirty-six (36) rods, thence North 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East four (4) rods thence North 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ degrees West fourteen (14) rods and twenty (22) links thence North 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East thirty-five (35) rods and fifteen (15) links thence North 24 degrees West seven (7) rods and five (5) links thence North 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East one hundred twenty-two (122) rods and twenty-two (22) links thence North 16 $\frac{3}{4}$ degrees East six (6) rods thence North 68 $\frac{1}{4}$ degrees East ten (10) rods and fifteen (15) links thence North 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East nine (9) rods and ten (10) links thence Northwesterly by said Hancock Street about fifty-seven (57) rods and eighteen (18) links to the point of beginning Said premises are conveyed subject to any and all existing rights of flouage as set forth or referred to in deed to Catherine B. Harkness recorded with Plymouth Deeds, Feb. 10 30 Page 260. Witness my hand and seal this seventh day of May 1919.
