Know All These by these Presents That I Charles H. Gurney of North Bridgewater, in the County of Plymouth and State of Massachusetts, married man, for consideration of six hundred dollars paid by Patrick Mcullough of said North Bridgewater the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give grant, sell, assign, set^o aside and release to

and assigns, A certain lot of land situated on the Westerly side of Montello street in said North Bridgewater bounded beginning on said street at the South east corner of the lot at a stake the corner of James Donahue's land thence Westerly in said Donahue's line nine rods more or less to the lot set off to widow Damaris W. Lyon for her dower thence Northwesterly in the line of said donor estate to the South line of a private way four rods more or less thence Easterly by the South line of said way eight rods more or less to land of Daniel Crocker thence South Easterly by said Crocker's land about two rods to Montello street thence easterly by Montello street to the place of beginning.

Also a small lot of land on the East side of Montello street nearly opposite the above containing about two square rods of land bounded North and East by land in possession of This J. Gurney, South by land of widow P. Donahue and West by said street;

I do hold the above granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Patrick Mcullough his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever.
