that we, Warren A. Howard and Mary A. Howard,
husband and wife, both of Brockton, in the County of
Plymouth and Commonwealth of Massachusetts,
in consideration of one dollar and other valuable consideration
paid by Daniel A. Howard of said Brockton.

the receipt whereon is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said
Daniel A. Howard a certain lot of land, with the
buildings thereon situated, on the West side of Main
Street in said Brockton bounded as follows, viz: Beginning
at a stone post set in the
ground at the corner bound of lands recently of Benjamin
Lynn Skinner, deceased, thence Westerly by the
line of the fence, and wall now standing, being
by latter recently of said Skinner sixteen (16) rods
more or less to each corner of the wall; thence southerly
in line of the wall by lands of said Skinner and
Cyrus P. Schinnerman, for his rods, more or less to a corner;
thence easterly in line of the fence, being by land
of said Cyrus P. Schinnerman, fifteen (15) rods more or
less to said street; thence southerly by said street to the
said first mentioned.

During the same premises, conveyed to Warren A.
Howard by Thomas D. McMurtry by Deed dated January
18th 1868, and recorded in Plymouth County Registry of
Deeds, Book 248, Page 115.

To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging,
to the said Daniel A. Howard
and his heirs and assigns, to their own, use and behoof, forever.
And the said Daniel A. Howard, his heirs, executors, and administrators,
covenant with the grantee and his heirs and assigns, that he will
lawfully settle in fee-simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances.

that the said Daniel A. Howard, his heirs, executors, and administrators shall, WARRANT AND DEFEND the same to the
grantee and his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all
persons.

And for the consideration aforesaid.

do hereby release unto the said grantee and
his heirs, executors, and administrators, all right of or to both
DOWER and JOINTURE in the granted premises.
