Mill at Plimouth. \*It is concluded vpon by the Court That Mr John Jenney shall have liberty to erect a Milne for grinding and beating of Corne vpon the brooke of Plymouth to be to him this heires for ever. And shall have a pottle of Corne toule vpon every bushell for grinding the same for the space of the two first yeares next after the said Milne is erected, and afterwardt but a quart at a bushell for all that is brought to the milne by others, but if he fetch it the grind it himself or by his servantt then to have a pottle toule for every bushell as before.
