in & County of Plymouth in the Colony of Massachusetts in New England Greeting
Know ye that I the said John Cushing for and in consideration
of other letters bought and conveyed by Benjamin Woodward of said County
unto the said John Cushing and his heirs in England which said letters enlarged
upon be given from the said Benjamin Woodward unto the said John Cushing bearing
witness with these presents whereunto I the said John Cushing do acknowledge
my self fully satisfied contented and paid and thereby and of every part
travel thereof do clearly acquit and discharge the said Benjamin Woodward
his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever by these presents
have given granted conveyed sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed unto
the said John Cushing for me and my heirs do freely fully and absolutely give grant
convey sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Benjamin Woodward
his heirs and assigns for ever several lots of land lying and being in
the Township of Little Compton in the County of Bristol in New England
as follows that is to say all my part of two lots of land of about fifty
acres and more which are in pasturage between Benjamin Woodward
and the said John Cushing the said John Cushing do hereby
sell and give the said twenty fifth and twenty sixth lots in Number
also one lot of land of a but three acres and is in Number the
eighteenth lot also one lot of land of about eighteen acres which
was formerly the lot of William Merrill and is in Number the
eighteenth lot also one other lot of land of a but three acres
called meadow lot which was formerly the lot of Benjamin Church
and is in Number the eighteenth lot and one other lot of land of
about three acres called meadow lot and is in Number the fourteenth
lot and also one third part of my right to purchase what land
may hereafter be purchased of the Indians in the Little Compton all
which said lots of land are lying and being in Little Compton
of said Township being due to the said John Cushing
for the more particular description and distinction of the
same and boundaries of all the above said lots the said John Cushing
do hereby certify that the said lots are in Number the twenty
fifth and twenty sixth lot said three acres lot in Number the
eighteenth lot and in Number the eighteenth lot
lot of land of about three acres called meadow lot in Number the
eighteenth lot and the other lot of land called meadow lot the fourth
lot in Number and said third part of right to purchase hereafter with
all and singular the benefits profits privileges and hereditaments what
soever thereto belonging in any way appertaining unto him the
said Benjamin Woodward his heirs and assigns for ever and to the one
wholly agreeable and behoof of him the said Benjamin Woodward his
heirs and assigns for ever and of the said John Cushing for
my self and for my heirs Executors and Administrators to and with
the said Benjamin Woodward his heirs and assigns do hereby Covenant
and Grant in manner and form following that is to say that
I the said John Cushing have God right full power and lawful
authority to Grant and Confirm all and singular the above
unto the said John Cushing and Seal this twenty third day of June in the year of
our Lord one thousand six hundred and ninety one 1691
