 Greeting. I have ye hand of the said John Cushing for and in Consideration
 of other good Reasons and Motives by proportion theron of Sealed and Delivered
 unto me with the said John Cushing and his heirs in England in which said Lands contained
 herein be saved from the said Benjamin Woodward with the said Cushing bearing
 Note with these presents wherewithal the said John Cushing to acknowledge
 my self fully satisfied contented and quiet and that he out of this present
 parcel thereof do clearly except and discharge the said Benjamin Woodward
 his heirs Executors Administrators and Assignees for ever by these presents
 have given granted bargained sold Alured Enfield and confirmed and by
 this presents for me and my heirs do freely fully and absolutely give and
 sell alien Enforce and Confirm unto of said Benjamin Woodward
 his Rents and Profits for ever several lots of Land lying and being in
 the Township of Little Compton in the County of Bristol in New England
 aforesaid that is to say all my part of two lots of land of about fifteen
 acres each which are in parcelling between Benjamin Woodward
 self land and the twenty fifth and twenty eighth lots in Number
 aforesaid one lot of land of about thirty acres and is in Number the
 eighteenth lot and one lot of land of about eighteen acres which
 was formerly the lot of William Smith and is in number the
 eighteenth lot also one other lot of land of about thirty acres
 called Meadow lot which was formerly the lot of Benjamin Church
 and is in Number of eighteenth lot and one other lot of land of
 about three acres called Meadow lot and is in Number the fourteenth
 lot and also one third part of my right the porch of which lies
 may here after be purchased of the Indians in the Little Compton of
 which said lots of lands are lying and being in Little Compton
 of original inhabitants being due to my right of said town or place
 for the more particular demonstration and distinguishing of the
 Limits and Boundaries of all of above said lots the same and to have
 all the aforesaid part of two fifty acres which are in Number the twenty
 fifth and twenty sixth lots for these are lot in number the eighteenth
 lot of about eighteen acres and in Number the eighteenth lot
 lot of land of about three acres called Meadow lot in Number the
 eighteenth lot and another lot of land called Meadow lot the fourth
 lot in Number and said third part of rights to purchase here after with
 all and Singular the Rights profits Privileges and hereditaments what
 ever thereunto belonging or any wayes pertaining unto him the
 said Benjamin Woodward his heirs and assigns for ever to the one
 only purpose and behoof of him the said Benjamin Woodward
 his heirs and assigns for ever and to the said John Cushing for
 my self and for my heirs Executors and Administrators to use with
 said Benjamin Woodward his heirs and assigns to pay his Rent
 and Grant his maner and forme following that is to say that
 if the said John Cushing have God right full power and lawfull
 Authority to grant and Confirm all and Singular the obser-
 vance of the said Deed to Seal this twenty third day of June in the year
 our Lord one thousand six hundred and ninety one 1691
