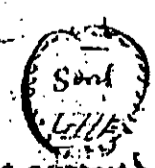


To all people to whom these presents shall come William Bradford of the Town and County of Plymouth in New England Esq. Greeting. Know ye that  
 As the said William Bradford as well for and in Confirmation of the Love and Good affection that I have and bear to my wellbelov'd friend and Son in law Joseph Holmes of Marshfield in the County aforesaid as also for Divers other his and valiant Considerations me at this time especially how unto moving have Given Granted Allowed Confirmed and Confirmed and by these presents for me and my heirs for ever Grant alien Enfeoff and absolutely Confirm from me and my heirs for ever unto him the said Joseph Holmes and to his heirs and Assigns for ever. All that Small part or parcel of my farm in Plymouth whereof I am now seized and possessed which so parcel of Land is estimated at thirty acres or it more or less and is bounded and bounded as followeth that is to say toward the East by or with a little brook that runneth into Jones river till it cometh to a marked bush tree standing on the west side of the said brook thence running on a straight line thirty rods west nor west north to a whit oak tree thence marked thence turning west running about forty eight rods on a North north west line nearest to another whit oak tree thence marked thence turning and running on a north line to about fourscore rods to a pine tree thence marked thence turning eastward and running on a straight line to the head of the brook above mentioned which brook is the boundary betwixt the townships of Duxbury and Plymouth according as it turneth & windeth and so is the easterly bounds of the said Granted land till it cometh to the marked bush tree aforesaid. And all my estate right title use possession Claim and Demand whatsoever of or unto the same with all and singular the rights privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said thirty acres of Land be it more or less within the limits and bounds above expressed with all and every its rights members and appurtenances unto him the said Joseph Holmes and to his heirs and Assigns for ever to his and their sole proper use benefit and behoof for ever. xxx  
 And if the said William Bradford for my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to and with the said Joseph Holmes his heirs and Assigns do Covenant promise and Grant by these presents in manner and form following that is to say: that at the time of executing and until the perfecting of these presents if the said William Bradford am the true and proper owner of the said Granted premises and have in my self full power to Grant alien and Confirm the same in manner and form aforesaid and that it shall & may be lawful to and for the said Joseph Holmes his heirs and Assigns from time to time and at all times for ever here after to have hold use occupy possess and enjoy all and every part of the said Granted premises with the appurtenances and have receive and take to his and their own use and behoof the product rents and profits arising therefrom for ever and all by force and virtue of these presents and lawfully for my self and my heirs I how by warrant to maintain the Grant aforesaid and against my self my heirs and Assigns, for ever to defend the said Joseph Holmes his heirs and Assigns in his and their peaceable enjoyment of the premises for testimony whereof I the said William Bradford have here unto set my hand and affixed my seal on the eighteenth day of March Anno Domini one thousand six hundred eighty eight or nine Anno regni regis Jacobi secundi Quinto.
