

To all people to whome these presents shall Come William Bradford of the Towne and
 County of Plymouth in New England Esq; Gentry, greeting. etc: knowe ye that
 A this said William Bradford as well for me and in Consideration of the love and good
 affection that of have and bear to my wellbeloved friend and Son in law Joseph Holme
 of Marshfield in the County aforesaid as also for divers other late and valuaable
 Considerations me at this time especially have unto memory have Given Granted
 Alligned Chyfested and Confirmed and by these presents for me and my heirs de
 sired Grantee and absolutely Confirm from me and my heirs de
 sired him the said Joseph Holme and to his heirs and assigns for ever all that
 Small part or parcel of my farme in Plymouth whereof I am now fized to
 possesse which said parcel of Land is estimated at thirtie acres or it more
 or less and is bounded and bounded as followeth that is to say toward
 the East by a little brooke that runneth into Jordan river till
 it comes to a marked tree standing on the south side of the said
 brooke thence running on a straight line thence westward
 to a whit oak tree thence turning east running about
 forty eight rods on a northward line runneth to another whit oak
 tree thence runneth thence turning and running on a north line
 about fourscore rods to a pine tree thence turning eastward
 and running on a straight line to the head of the brooke above mentioned
 which brooke is the boundary betwixt the townships of Duxbury and Plymouth
 according as it turneth C windeth and so is the eastern bounde of the said
 Granted land till it comes to the marked tree abovesaid. And all
 my Estate right title we possession (Laines and Domains whatsoever of me and
 unto this farme with all land singular therin rights memberes and appurtenances
 to the same belonging or in any wise appertaininge to have and to hold
 the said thirtie acres of Land or it more or less within the limits and boundes
 above expressed with all and every its rights memberes and appurtenances
 unto him the said Joseph Holme and to his heires and assigns for ever
 And of the said Willmack Bradford for my self my heires Executors and
 Administrators to and with the said Joseph Holme his heires and assigns
 do Covenant promis and Grant by these presents in manner and forme
 following that is to say that at the time of executing and until the perfecting
 of these presents of the said William Bradford am the true and proper owner
 of the said Granted premises and have in my self full power to grant agree
 and covenante the same in manner and forme aforesaid and that it shall
 may be lawfull to and for the said Joseph Holme his heires and assigns
 from time to time and at all times for ever here after to have held
 esp. occupie possess and enjoy all and every part of the said Granted
 premises with the appurtenances and have recorde and take to his and
 their use and behoove the product rents and profits arising therefrom
 for ever and all by force and vertue of these presents and lastly
 for my self and my heire, & how by evancke to maintain the same
 aforesaid and against my self my heire and assigns, for ever to
 defend the said Joseph Holme his heires and assigns in his and their
 lawfull enjoyment of the premises for testimony whereof of the
 Said William Bradford have here unto set my hand and affixed my
 seal on the eighteenth day of March anno Domini one thousand six
 hundred eighty eight or nine, during the reign of King Jacobi second.
