Know all men By These Presents, That I Lemuel Pope of Boston in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, in consideration of a bond from the Kingston Aqueduct association signed by Francis Johnson, Thomas Russell and Jonah Mullis (a committee chosen at a legal meeting to give said bond) of even tenor and date with this deed, Said bond being an obligation to supply with water the House and Barn of said Pope the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell, and convey unto the said Kingston Aqueduct Association a certain lot of land situate on Jones river, in Kingston and County of Plymouth and bounded as follows, viz. commencing at the South West corner of the land of Joseph S. Beal. in said river, thence by said Beal's line on to the upland one

To Have and to Hold the above granted premises to the said Kingston Aqueduct Association their heirs and assigns, to their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant with the said Kingston Aqueduct Association their heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the abovementioned premises; that they are free of all incumbrances, except to be used only for an Aqueduct and the Reservation above that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Kingston Aqueduct Association And that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Kingston Aqueduct Association their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

In witness whereof, I the said Lemuel Pope have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighteenth day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty nine
