

Know all Men by these Presents,

that I, Caleb Bates of Kingston in the County of Plymouth and Commonwealth of Massachusetts,

in consideration of forty six dollars and eighty seven cents paid by B. Brewster and Esq' of said Kingston.

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said B. Brewster & Esq', a certain lot of land adjoining the land of the said Company and being a part of my mill lot in Kingston bounded as follows viz: Beginning at the North corner of the land of said Brewster & Esq', thence North 58 East, Eight rods by the land of the estate of H. L. Adams; thence South 12° E. two rods and eight links; thence south 34° West, ten and one quarter rods to a stone monument by the side of the stream of running twenty links south easterly from the East corner of the land of said Company, then beginning at the same North corner and running South 13° E. six rods; thence south 73° 1/4 West four rods to the stream; thence easterly by the stream to the said stone monument containing thirty seven and one half square rods. Nevertheless reserving all rights of flowage which I now have or the right to flow upstream to the point where my present line intersects with the racing of said stream, but reserving no right to flow above a hole drilled in a rock in the center of the waste way forty seven feet below the stone dam. The right to lower the bed of the stream to any desired point is also granted.

To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said B. Brewster & Esq' and their heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever.

And I do hereby, for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said grantees and their heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee-simple of the granted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances.

that I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall WARRANT AND DEFEND the same to the said grantees and their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

As for the consideration aforesaid I, Caleb Bates and Caroline M. Bates, wife of Caleb Bates aforesaid do hereby release unto the said grantees and their heirs and assigns, all right of or to both DOWER AND HOMESTEAD in the granted premises.
