remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said

from said conveyance. To have and to hold the granted
premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances there-
to belonging to the said City of Brockton and its suc-
cessors and assigns to their own use and behoof forever.
And I do hereby, for myself and my heirs, executors,
and administrators, covenant with the said grantee
and its successors and assigns that the granted premises
are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me
except as aforesaid and that I will and my heirs, ex-
ecutors, and administrators shall Warrant and Defend
the same to the said grantee and its successors and assigns
in the granted premises and all rights by statute therein
