

* Know All Men by these Presents that I Martin Southworth of North Bridgewater in the County of Plymouth Yeoman In consideration of Three hundred seventy five dollars paid by Edward E. Bennett of North Bridgewater aforesaid Yeoman the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby give grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Edward E. Bennett a certain lot of land with one half part of a Barn thereon standing situated in North Bridgewater ^{bounth} beginning on the South side of the Road at a stake opposite the house of Nathan Packard thence South three quarters of a degree West passing through the middle of the Barn nine rods seventeen links to a stake standing One rod South of the Barn, thence East One degree South one rod seven links to the end of a wall thence South 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ East by a wall five rods eight links thence South 17 $\frac{3}{4}$ East sixteen rods three links to a stake, thence South by a wall twenty rods eleven links to land formerly owned by Elkan Warren thence West by a stone wall thirty three rods seventeen links to a corner at Perce Southworth's line, thence North one degree East in the line of said Perce's land and by the wall fifty rods fifteen links to the Highway, thence Eastly by the road twenty four rods fifteen links to the station first mentioned saving and reserving to Nathan Packard his heirs and assigns a convenient Cartway from the aforesaid road to and from said Barn. To have and to hold the above granted premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Edward E. Bennett his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever And I the said Martin Southworth for myself and any Heirs Executors and Administrators do covenant with the said Edward E. Bennett his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises, that they are free from all encumbrances. That I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Edward E. Bennett as aforesaid, and that I will and my Heirs Executors and Administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Edward E. Bennett his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. In witness whereof I the said Martin Southworth and J. Ruth wife of said Martin hereby relinquishing my Right of Dower in the premises have hereunto set our Hands and Seals this eighth day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty seven.
