

On the petition of Van R. Swift and others, Selectmen
Swift & others of Bridgewater, representing that nearly all of the old
Bridgewater road leading from the corner near Cyrus P. Brown's res-
idence in West Bridgewater Southly and over Skin Milk
bridge as called, to a point a little North of the late

The County Commissioners pursuant to an order of
notice for that purpose, duly published, posted & served,
as appears by the officers return, by which all persons and
corporations interested, had due notice, met to view
the premises and to hear all persons and corporations
interested, at the Hopland House in Bridgewater, in
said County on the fourth day of June A. D. 1874: and
after viewing the premises, and hearing all persons and
corporations interested therein, they adjourned said pro-
ceedings from time to time, all persons and corpora-
tions interested having due notice thereof, to the Regular
Meeting of said Commissioners held at Plymouth in
said County on the third Tuesday of March A. D. 1875,
when and where they adjudicate and determine that
common convenience and necessity require - that the
old road in said Street Bridgewater and Bridgewater
leading from the corner, near Cyrus P. Brown's residence
in said West Bridgewater, Southly and over Skin Milk
Bridge, as called, to a point a little North of the late
residence of Martin Follen, in Bridgewater, except so much
of it, as is within the limits of a new road recently loca-
ted by order of the County Commissioners, be discontinued
as a public highway.

and for said purpose, and heard all persons & corporations
who desired to be heard, and proceeded to discontinue
said highway, as follows, to wit:

They hereby discontinue as a public highway, so much
of the old road in said Street Bridgewater & Bridgewater
leading from the corner near the residence of Cyrus P.
Brown in said West Bridgewater, Southly and over Skin
Milk Bridge, as called, to a point a little North of the
residence of Martin Follen in Bridgewater, except so
much of it, as is within the limits of a new road
recently located by order of the County Commissioners,

No person or corporation suffers damage by such dis-
continuance, no damages are awarded.

Given under our hands and seal at
Plymouth, in said County, this twenty
seventh day of April, in the year eighteen
hundred and seventy five, this return
being now made and accepted.
